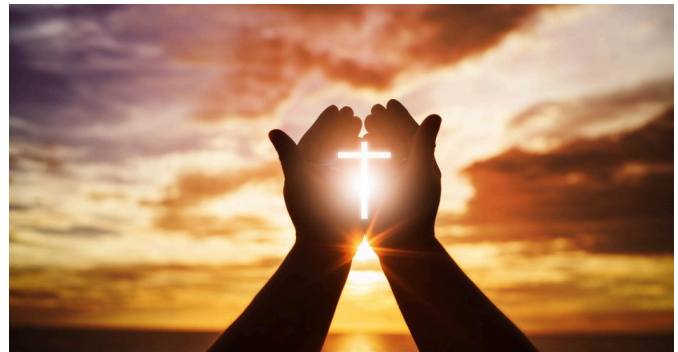

Royal Visit

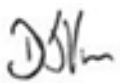
