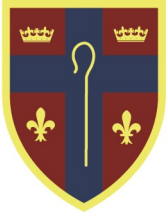

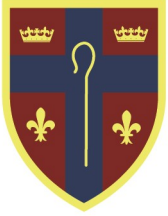

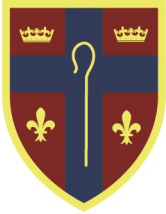

We had an excellent turn out at our first netball practice of the year. It was great to see all the girls motivated to be playing netball again. Well done girls, keep up the good work.



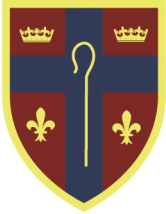
Congratulations to some of our amazing girls who have been

The UK's Central Link for Educational Theatre

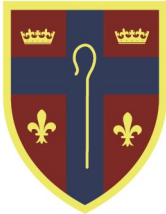
We are really excited to be hosting Theatre for Schools next week for their plays:
